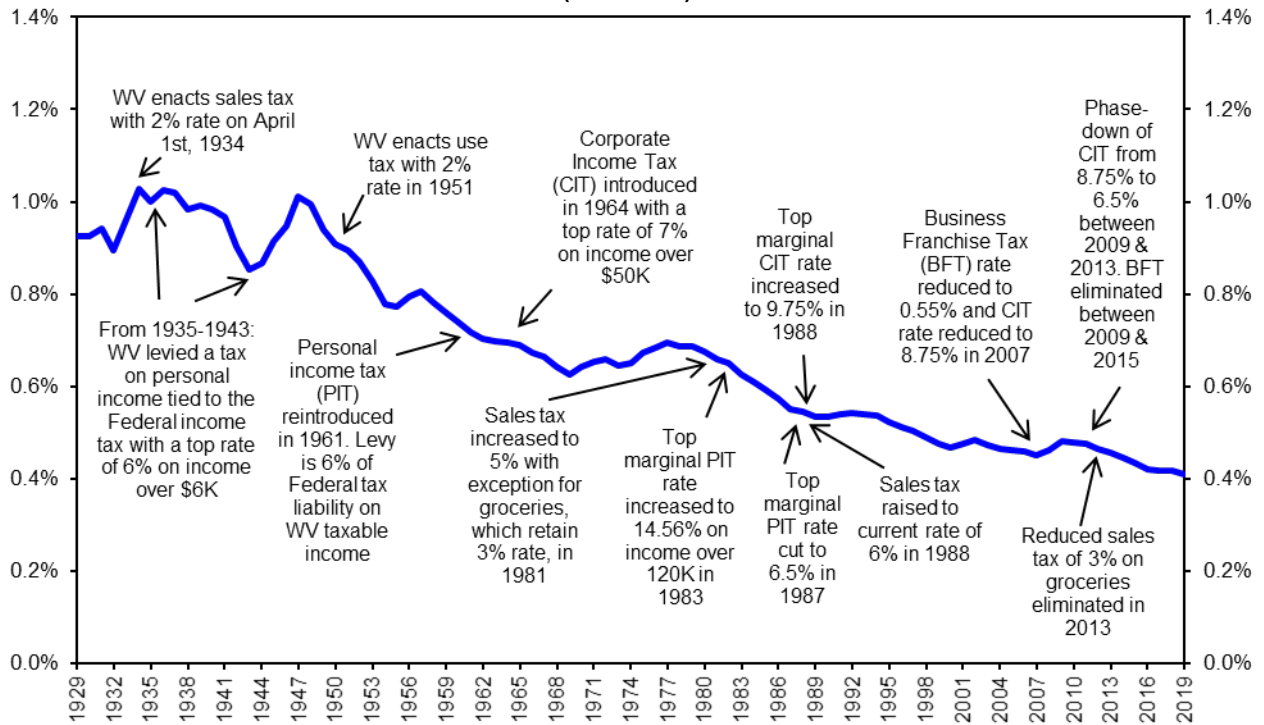




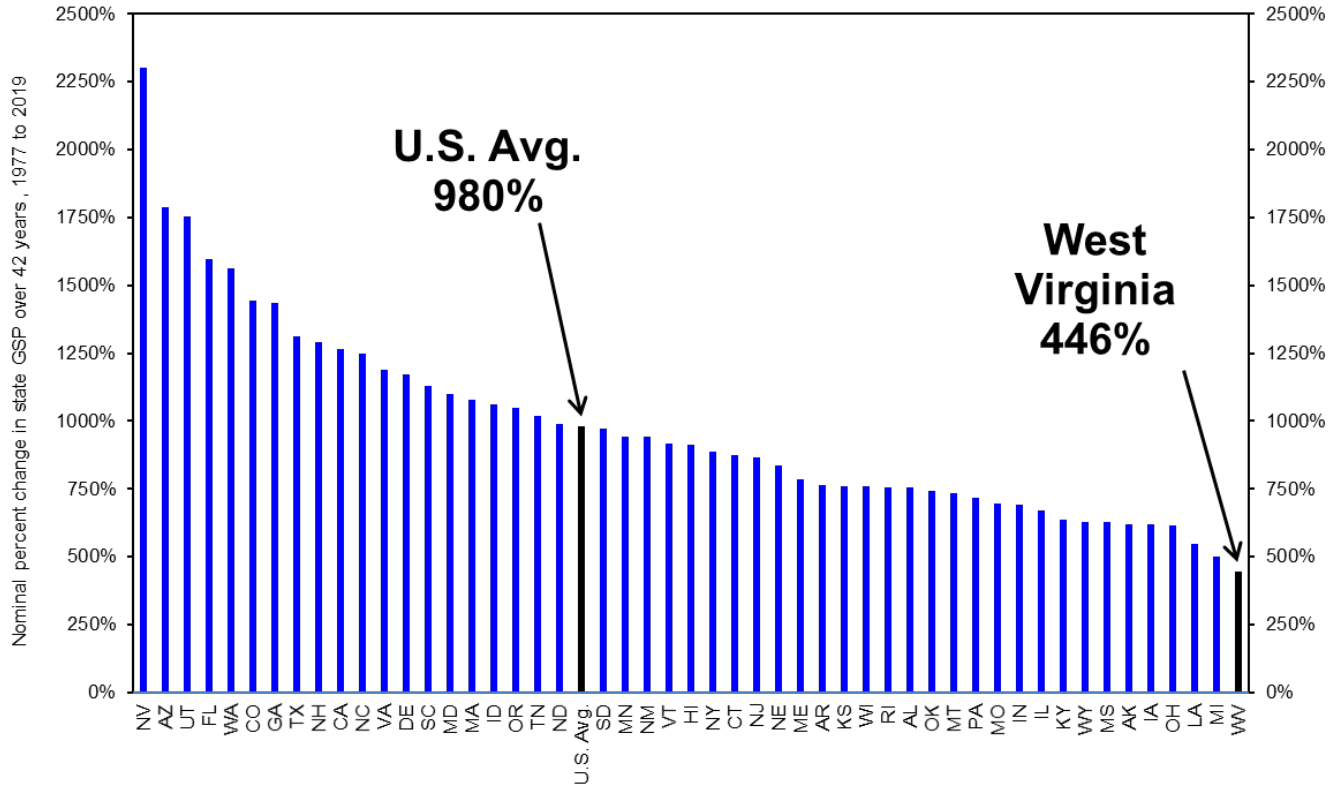

(1977-2019, current dollars)**

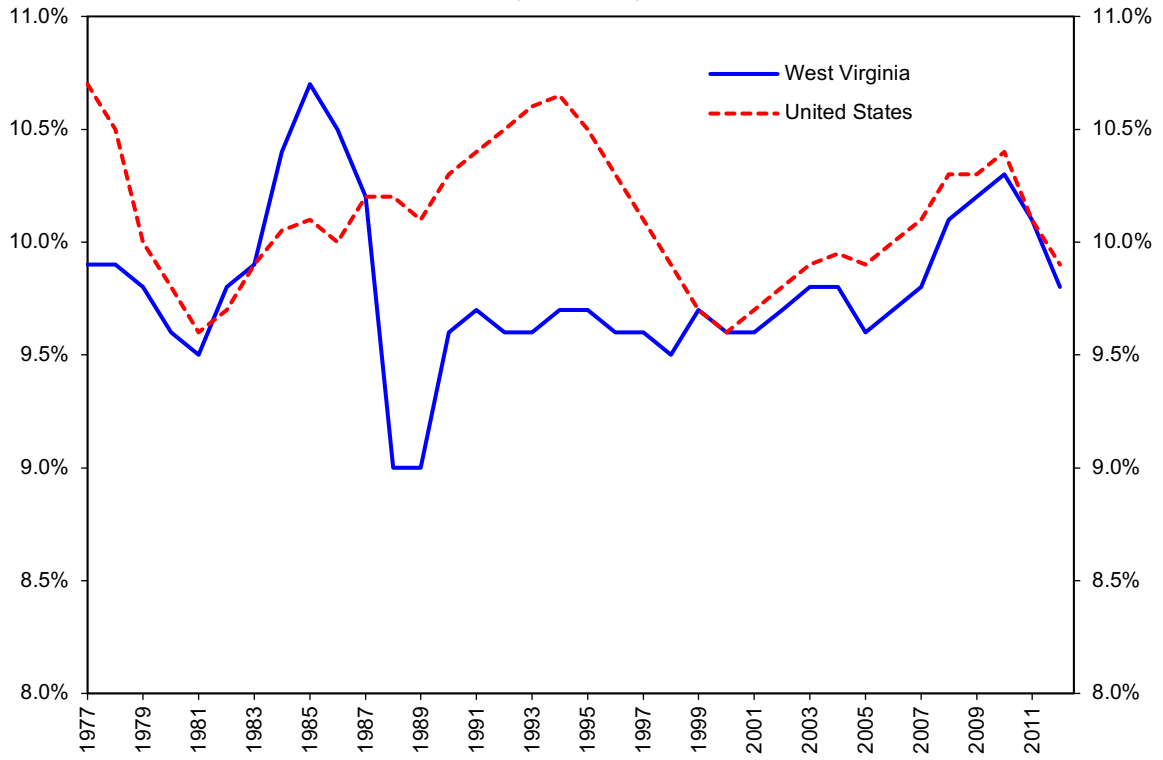

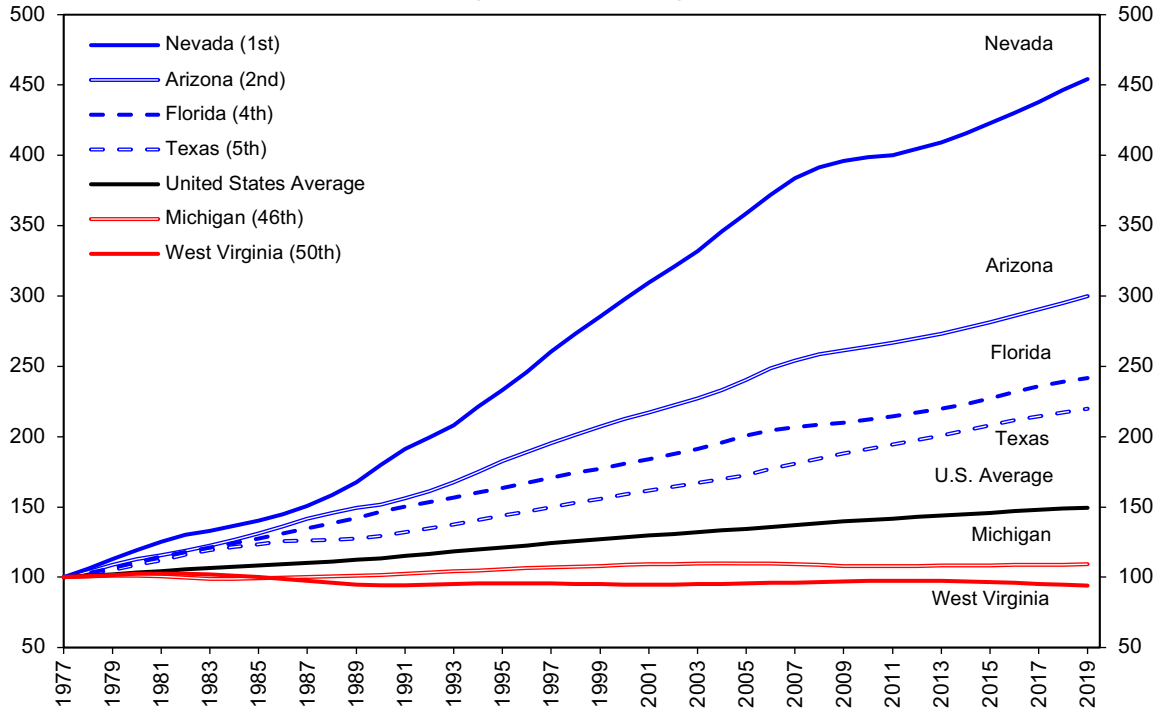

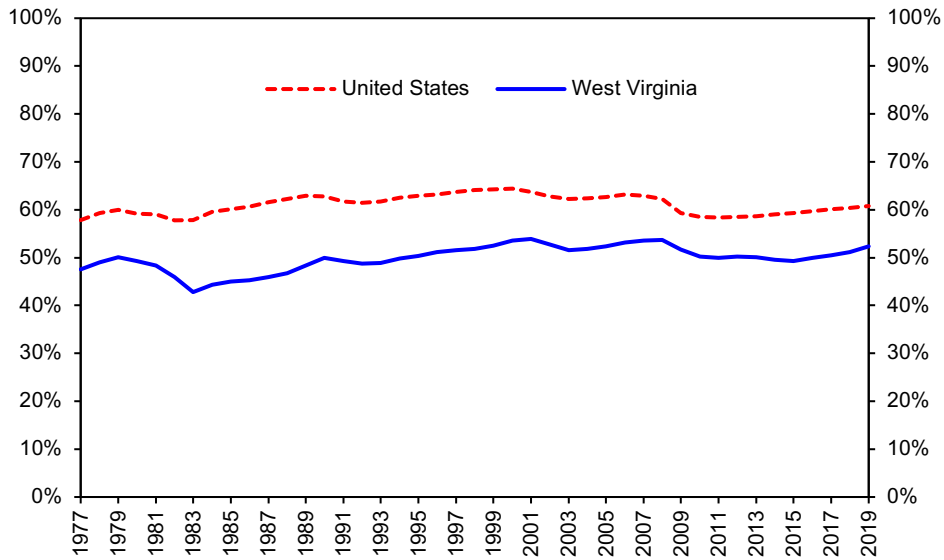
**Tax Burden

(1977-2012)**



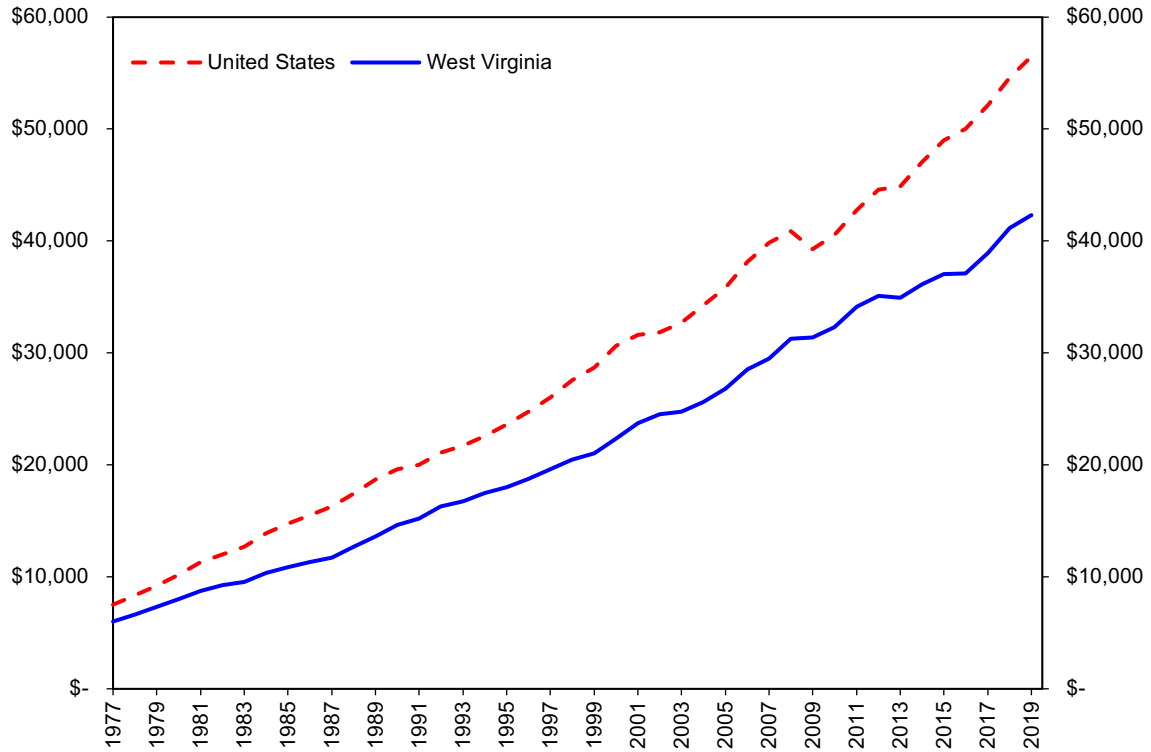
**Population

(Index, 1977 = 100)**



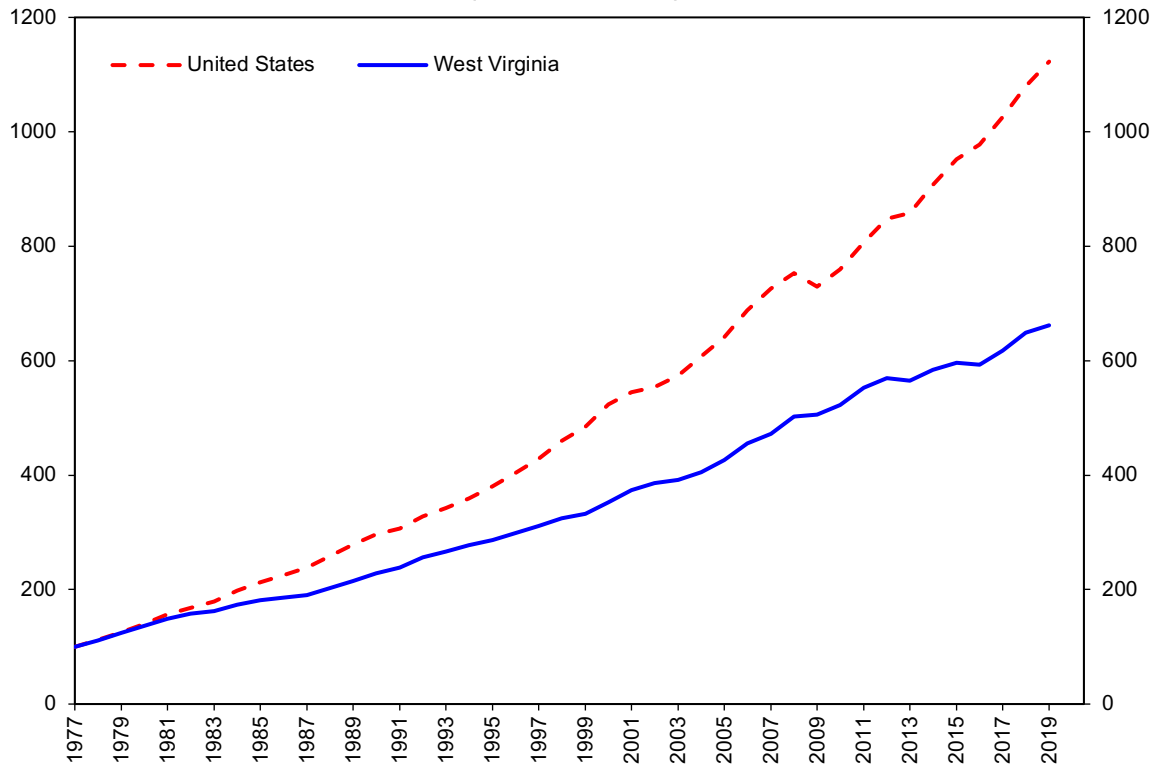
**Employment to Adult Population Ratio

(1977-2019)**



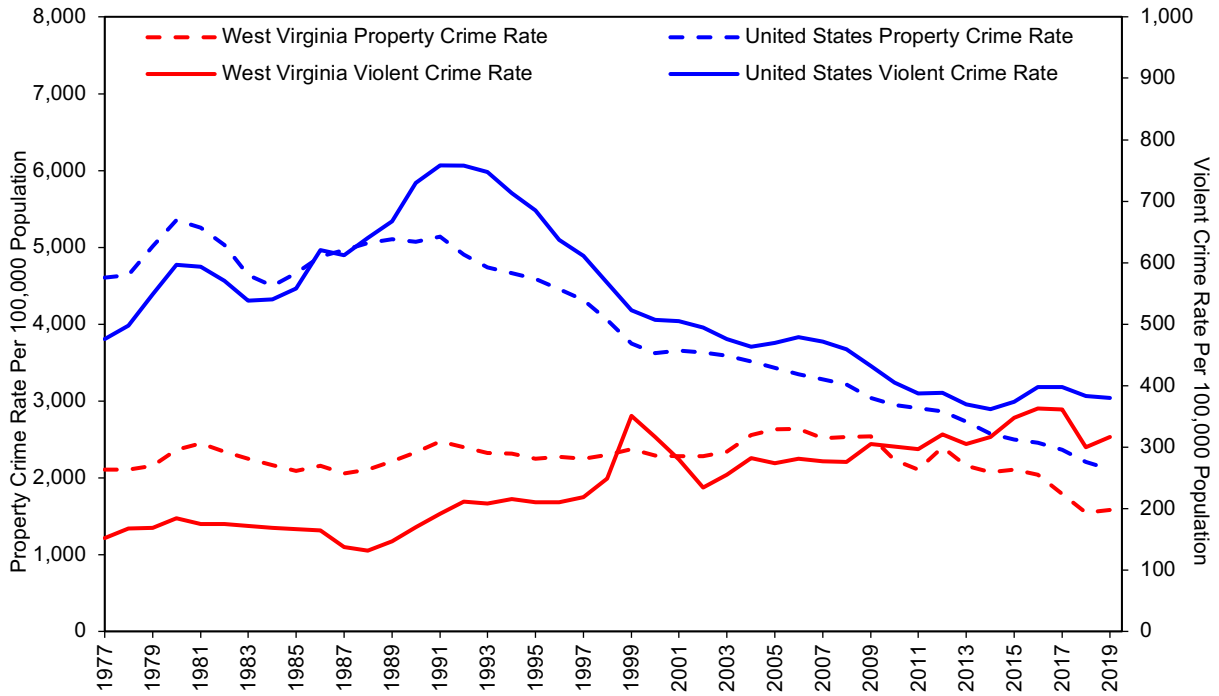
**Personal Income Per Capita
